



Introduction


- Mining means extracting something useful or valuable from a baser substance, such as mining gold from the earth.
- Web mining is the process of using data mining techniques and algorithms to extract information directly from the Web.





Types of Web mining

- Three types of Web mining:
 - Web Content Mining
 - Web Structure Mining
 - Web Usage mining





Web Content Mining


- To extract the useful information from any web document, this type of web mining is used
- Provides effective and interesting patterns about the user needs and behavior
- Also known as text mining and it performs scanning and mining of the text, images, etc.





Web Structure Mining


- Basically, shows the structure of any website
- The structure of a typical Web graph consists of Web pages as nodes, and hyperlinks as edges connecting between two related pages
- Two types of web structural data:
 - extracting the patterns from hyperlinks in the web
 - mining the document structure





Web Usage Mining

- Identifying or discovering interesting usage patterns from large data
- Also called log mining
- Classification based on usage data:
 - Web-server data
 - Application-server data
 - Application-level data





Applications

- 1. Web search engines use web mining to classify the web documents and identify the web pages.
- 2. It is used for web searching and vertical searching.
- 3. It is also used to predict user's behavior
- 4. Landing page optimization is also done by web mining
